General Instructions:	<p>GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS (CO) Spinogel Roach With Natural Spinosad is designed to control pest species of cockroaches including American and German. The slight delay in mortality caused by the active ingredient, spinosad, allows cockroaches to consume the bait and return to the harbourage site to contaminate other cockroaches. It contains the active ingredient spinosad, a powerful, non-repellent insecticide.</p> <p>Use Instructions To apply the gel, unscrew the cap on the nozzle and touch the tip to the surface to be treated and slowly squeeze tube until sufficient gel is dispensed. Recap the tube after treatment is completed. Where maintenance treatments form part of the professional pest controller's contract, it is recommended that cockroach activity be monitored where gel had been applied 1 month after initial treatment or at more regular intervals in areas of high infestation. Where application of a non-repellent spray is required it is recommended that a suitable registered product such as EnsnarePRO 50 SC be applied according to the registered label on that product.</p> <p>(DM) Spinogel Roach With Natural Spinosad is designed to control pest species of cockroaches including American and German. American Cockroach, German Cockroach, other common cockroaches	Apply at least 2 spots/m ² . Increasing the number of spots (up to 5/m ²) may be required for heavy infestations or if American Cockroaches are the main pest. Recommended spot size is approximately 5 mm diameter (0.1 g)	<p>Spinogel Roach With Natural Spinosad should be applied to areas frequented by cockroaches such as between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading into voids and hollow spaces in floors, walls, ceilings, equipment legs and bases, around plumbing pipes, doors and windows, and behind and under appliances, cabinets, sinks, closets and any other equipment that cockroaches are typically known to hide.</p> <p>Spinogel Roach With Natural Spinosad should be applied as a small spot of material, approximately 0.1 g (approximately 5 mm in diameter – the size of a small pea). Several small applications distributed within an area are more effective than 1 or 2 applications of large quantities. In some cases a small thin bead (less than 2.5 mm wide and 5 cm long) may be appropriate. Bait placements should be inspected periodically for consumption and reapplied as needed. It is recommended that PESTIE DOTZ® are used when applying Spinogel Roach With Natural Spinosad to aid in accurate bait size placement, to monitor bait consumption and to identify where bait placements were made previously. A typical infestation may require as little as 15 g of Spinogel Roach With Natural Spinosad whereas heavy infestations in large structures may require the use of several tubes of gel bait.</p> <p>Where application of a non-repellent spray is required it is recommended that a suitable registered product such as EnsnarePRO® 50 SC be applied according to the registered label on that product.</p>

Repeat when spots start to disappear.</p>
